This year, several prize-winning young artists and ensembles will make their debuts with MITV:

- *Enso String Quartet*, nominated for a Grammy Award for *Best Chamber Music Performance* for 2009
- *Trio Cavatina*, winner of the coveted Naumberg Chamber Music Award
- Violinist Nikki Chooi, winner of the 2009 Irving M. Klein International Violin Competition
- Italian pianist Alessandro Taverna, winner of the prestigious 2009 Yamaha International Piano-e-Competition.
- Brilliant young cellist Joshua Roman, dubbed a “classical rock star” by critics in the classical press
- Pianist William Wolfram, winner of the silver medal at both the William Kapell and the Naumberg International Piano Competitions

The *Pacifica Quartet* returns for a two week residency, featuring an all-Shostakovich recital, as well as Schubert's epic quartet “Death and the Maiden.”

Other highlights include a string quartet by Gordon Getty and Olivier Messiaen's “Quartet For The End Of Time,” written while interned in a German POW camp in World War II.

We hope to see you in the audience this August and share a glass of wine with you at intermission!
